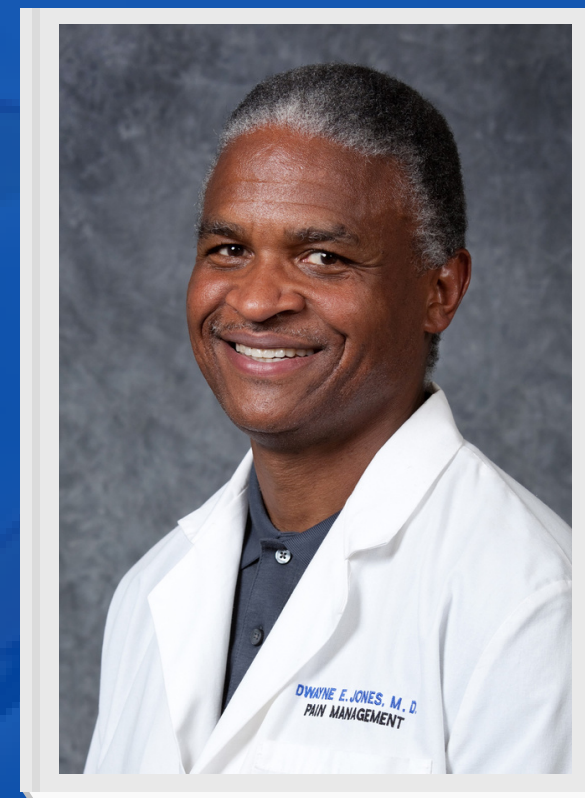

Referral Process

Dr. Jones suggests that you be referred to him by a medical provider (family physician, surgeon, nurse practitioner, chiropractor, etc.). This facilitates obtaining previous medical information relative to your condition prior to your appointment.

Evaluating your pain condition is our primary concern. The initial evaluation will determine the true cause of your pain. Dr. Jones will review the results of previous diagnostic tests and may recommend additional medical tests to further identify the cause of your pain.

Dr. Jones will work with you to create an individualized plan of treatment for your pain so that you may resume everyday activities.
